**Trinity OPC — Huntington, WV** (Grace OPC/ Columbus, OH)  
Organizing Pastor David Robbins and his family moved into their home in Huntington in May. Pastor David reports he has labored hard to stabilize the mission work. There have been significant counseling needs that have taken his time. The congregation has been supportive of his ministry and the families are committed to working together in outreach. David believes he has made progress in reaching out to neighbors and others in the community. Pray that God would provide someone with desire and ability to accompany worship on the piano. Pray that God would guide David and the members with outreach ideas and encouragement in their witness to Christ. Attendance is in the mid twenties.

**Lake OPC – Cleveland, OH** (Covenant OPC /Mansfield, OH) God has blessed the use of the newer meeting place and the regular Sunday morning worship. Additional families have been discipled and approved for membership following interviews by the overseeing session. Attendance is in the upper thirties and has pushed 50 several times. Lake has had the fellowship of many visiting OP families traveling the “north coast” on their way home or on vacation. Several individuals have taken up organizing fellowship activities and the members enjoy these times. We’ve also had some young adults visit as they move into the area taking up internships or study through the Cleveland Clinic and the various colleges in town. Pray that we can be an effective witness for the reformed faith to these and many other people who have inquired. Pray that God will also raise up officer candidates to begin training in the fall.



**Redeemer OP Mission –Wilkesburg/Pittsburgh, PA** Families continue to gather for worship and there is ongoing discipleship. Local giving has been stable and the mission has the help of area OPC pastors

and elders. The building remains unsold and so continues to be available to the mission. With seven families the leadership has been seeking to find an evangelist to come in order to build up the work so an organizing pastor can be fully supported. Monies have been promised and a budget developed. Pray that God would provide a man to lead this mission effort.



**Grace OPC Mission – Huron, OH** (Covenant OPC/Mansfield, OH). Grace continues to meet for worship on Sunday evenings at the



conference center of the Kalahari resort near Sandusky, with Pastor Oldaker preaching. Attendance is steady in the mid-20's. Pastor Oldaker leads a Bible study on Tuesday evenings and has spent time discipling and counseling seeking to strengthen the core group of seven families.
