

We anticipate a great week at **Camp Piedmont** just off of I-70 in eastern Ohio. Recreation opportunities include pool swimming, full basketball court, shooting range, archery, boating, and organized sports. Senior camp is designed for students who have finished 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, or 12<sup>th</sup> grade. You are eligible to attend the summer after you graduate from high school. In fact we encourage it!

**Camp staff** this year will include Elder James Alexander as Camp Director. Pastor Bob McKelvey (Westminster OPC) will be the Assistant Director and will be our morning Bible Teacher and Vesper's Teacher. He will be teaching on "Fight the Good Fight" Christine Wilson will direct the crafts.

**Room assignments** are at the discretion of the camp director. Therefore, requests for cabin assignments together will be limited to one other person. Both persons must request assignment with each other in order for it to be granted.

**DIRECTIONS:**

**From the East:** Exit I-70 in Ohio at exit # 202 and follow SR 800 North about 9 miles.  
**From the West:** Exit I-70 in Ohio at exit # 198, Turn Left/North on CR 114, then turn Right/East on Old National 40A. At the stop sign, turn Left/North on SR 800. Follow SR 800 for 6 miles. Turn Right/East onto 4H Camp Rd at the sign for about 1 mile. Following the 4-H signs, Bear Left/North onto Briarwood Dr; Bear Right/East up the hill onto Briar Hill Rd for about 1/2 mile, then bear Left at the next intersection for another 1/2 mile on

the gravel road. Bear Right onto 4H Club Rd and arrive at the camp. Follow signs to registration.
